SACRAMENTS

Sacrament of Baptism- The sacrament of Baptism will be celebrated on Sundays after 11:00 a.m. Mass. Please call the Parish Office at least two months in advance in order to make arrangements. Parents must be registered in the parish and active for at least three months prior to the Baptism.

Sponsors must be canonically eligible.

Certificates of Eligibility- sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation requires that a person be an active, registered member of the parish three months prior to receiving the certificate of eligibility. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Marriage- Please call the Parish Office at least 6 months before the proposed marriage dates in order to arrange for the necessary preparation. An appointment is necessary before a wedding date may be scheduled. Parish and Diocesan pre-marital classes are required. Only parish guidelines will be followed in planning the marriage ceremony.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

On the Fourth Sunday of Lent, March 30, 2025, known as <u>Laetare Sunday</u>, the church encourages joy and hope amidst the penitential season, with prayers reflecting on the <u>reconciliation</u> and <u>rejoicing</u> of the <u>Easter</u> season.

The name Laetare Sunday comes from the entrance antiphon, or "Introit," for Mass on the fourth Sunday of Lent: Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast

Laetare is the first word — meaning "rejoice" — in the Latin text.
